On Friday 28th September, the photographer will be at the Upper School for individual photographs. Please contact the Junior School Office (020 679 3060) to arrange group photographs for you family.


Our Sports Day, postponed in the summer due to bad weather, will take place on Monday 1st October at the Olympic Stadium, weather permitting. A decision to proceed or not will be made at 8am on the Monday morning, according to the conditions. More information to follow closer to the day.

The Scouts and Cubs desperately need adult help – if they do not get adults to volunteer to supervise their activities, both groups are in real danger of closing. If you are able and willing to offer your support on Fridays between 4pm and 6pm (Cubs) or between 6pm and 8pm (Scouts), please get in touch with me at the Upper School.

The Key Stage 3 and 4 students will soon be offered options for the Enrichment Afternoon, due to start on 3rd October. The options will comprise activities not normally covered in the school curriculum and will include initially: sailing, kayaking, ceramics, jazz band, advanced recorder consort, handchimes, performance arts and ICT. The Year 10 and 11 students will also have the opportunity to begin working for their Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award, known as the International Young Person's Award here in the Netherlands. Later in the year we will offer alternative activities such as fencing and ice-skating. I should point out that for sailing and kayaking, only confident swimmers can be accepted and parents will be required to sign a confirmation of the child's swimming competence.

Finally, can I please appeal to parents to make sure that all children bring a coat to school. The weather is certainly turning chillier and we often have rain during the day, even if it is dry when they leave home.
